- **OPEN Session:** \$24 p/p (60min session with full slalom gate use. Max 30 people per session, min. 15 people)
- **OPEN 20 Session:** \$36 p/p (60min session with full gate use. Max 20 people per session, min. 10 people. Used only as an option to make slalom training available when minimum numbers for OPEN sessions cannot be met).
- **Training during Rafting and Recreational Paddling:** \$20 p/p per hour or \$38 for the day (60min water time with upstream gates only).
- **Exclusive Whitewater:** \$700 per hour. (60min water time with full slalom gate use. Max 30 people).

## **Technical Video Service**

The competition will be covered by a mixed video feed, provided by the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS). This will be available in the TVS area.

We will be providing a HD video service with no loss of quality from the cameras to you. In order to maintain HD video we will be using HDMI cables to deliver the ODD and EVEN feed. The video will be provided over two cables in PAL format.

Stations will be set up in the TVS tent with an odd cable and an even cable at each station. There is a limited number of stations. It is essential that you notify Sue Natoli (suenatoli@gmail.com) if you intend to access the Technical Video service.

All teams will be responsible for providing their own connectors and video recording equipment.

The cables provided will have a male HDMI connector and Teams will need to supply connectors to connect their video gear.

If your Video Equipment does not have a HDMI connection you may need to convert to RCA this can be done with a HDMI to RCA converter.



There will be opportunity for teams to discuss and resolve technical issues prior to the competition and to test equipment during the demonstration runs however, it is important that teams purchase the correct connectors prior the event. If you have any questions please ask Sue Natoli before the event. Sue Natoli and staff from the AIS will have limited capacity to troubleshoot during the event.

## **Visa information**

Under Australia's universal visa system, all visitors to Australia must have a valid visa to travel to and enter Australia (other than New Zealand passport holders who will normally be granted a Special Category visa on arrival, provided they meet health and character requirements. For more information, see the fact sheet: <http://www.immi.gov.au/media/fact-sheets/17nz.htm>

**It is recommended for applicants who are applying for a visa, to lodge their application at least 8-12 weeks before their intended travel date to Australia.**

### **Visa options**

#### **Amateur sports people**

There are a number of visa options for amateur sports people and their support staff (which is including, but not restricted to, the coaches, trainers, team officials and team managers).

The following information will help you identify the most appropriate visa option. Eligible passport holders who are travelling to Australia to participate in an event of up to three months on an amateur basis can apply free of charge for an eVisitor (Subclass 651) visa. A list of eVisitor eligible passports can be found below.

#### **eVisitor**

European Union (EU) passport holders, and some other European passport holders, are eligible to apply individually online for an eVisitor (Subclass 651) visa to travel to and enter Australia.

A separate online eVisitor (Tourist stream) application is required for each family member who holds a passport from an eligible country and wishes to travel with you to Australia, including children under the age of 18 who are included on your passport. Applications for eVisitor visas are free.

Alternatively, amateur sports people (and their support staff) who have been invited by an Australian organisation to participate in an event for up to 3 months can apply for a Temporary Work (Short Stay Activity) (Subclass 400) visa and be eligible for exemption from paying the Visa Application Charge (VAC)

### **Temporary Work (Short Stay Activity) visa (Subclass 400)**

If you are entering Australia to participate in a short-term, non-ongoing sporting event or events you may apply for the Temporary Work (Short Stay Activity) visa (Subclass 400).

This visa is usually valid for six weeks or less from the date you first enter Australia, but it can be granted for up to three months if the department agrees you need to stay for that time. You must arrive in Australia within three months from the date the visa is granted.
