IMPORTANT NOTICE CONCERNING C-BOAT RACES IN THE 2017 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

We want to draw your attention to a potential problem in particular concerning the races for C-boats in the World Championships.

It is well known that we often have problems with entries in some of these races, and due to having the Championships in South Africa where we have been told there will be limited number of C-boats for rent it may require long and time-consuming boat transport for most teams and this may become a problem.

Deadlines for entries are as follows:

Numerical 24 July
Nominal 21 August.

According to our information boat transport from Europe is expected to leave no later than **week 29 (17-23 July)** and consequently boats may be on their way before we know if a class will be approved as a Championships event and run. As you will know we need 6 national teams in a race for it to be approved.

To meet this challenge and try to avoid problems for some teams it is important that we know which countries intend to paddle the C-boat races. We therefore suggest that those teams who intend to paddle in the races below inform us of this.

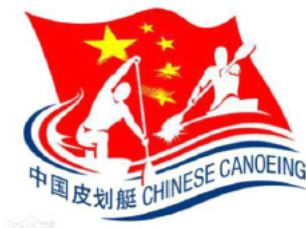

ICF Canoe Marathon World Cup – Shaoxing and Shanghai, China

21-27 October 2017

The World Cup will be a combination of 2 venues near each other, Shaoxing which is chosen for the 2019 World Championships and Shanghai.

See enclosed bulletin with details of the event.

The organizers have secured top level competition by inviting 40 top paddlers based on the 2016 World Championships results. By this, all 5 continents are secured representation in the competitions.

There is no limitation for entries in all classes in the World Cup competition.

INTERNATIONAL TECHNICAL OFFICIAL EXAMINATION

Examination to become International Technical Official is offered to be conducted in connection with the World Championships in **Pietermaritzburg, South Africa, on Tuesday 5th September 2017**. It will include a seminar for the candidates, and a candidate who passes the exam will following join the World Championships ITO group as trainee to conclude the examination process.

For nominations and examination rules, please check with the ICF Canoe Marathon Rules article 11. Only National Federations are entitled to nominate candidates for examination **at least 30 days before the examination**.

CURRENT POSITION IN THE WORLD RANKING 2016-17

The Classic Series races, the World Cups and the World Championships are combined into a World Series for K1 Men and Women, C1 Men and Women, with a point system leading to the World Ranking with World Championships as the final event where the winners of each of the 4 classes will receive an ICF Trophy.

- World Cup Hazewinkel Belgium – 27-28 May 2017
