1. Generals

Your team gets qualified at the ICF Canoe Polo World Championships 2016 in Syracuse congratulation!. You get the invitation from our ICF office and you declare your teams can take part. My name is Joachim Schwarzrock. I'm a Polo People and the Competition Manager for Canoe Polo at this World Games. I will try to make sure the best conditions for our sport. So I also try to provide all input you need to come to Wroclaw. I have attached the Bulletin 1-3 of the World Games organization to this Canoe Polo bulletin. It provides the most required information to help in your decision.

2. Wroclaw

Wroclaw is a big city in Poland, which is located not far from Poznan, which some of us knows from our WC 2012 and EC 2013. It takes approximately 45 minutes per plane to go there from Frankfurt (GER) or Warsaw, the capital of Poland. It's also easy to go there by car. You have to pay there in Zloty (PLN). 4 PLN ~ 1 € . When I visited the site everything was secure, clean and nice. The temperature in July is between 20° to 30° Celsius

3. Organizational issues

Our competition will be held in a new outdoor swim center "Orbitra". They presented to me the old two swim center and now at the 2nd Competition Manager meeting, the total new one with a 50 m Indoor Pool (in case of a hurricane we can easy switch) a 50 m Outdoor pool and a fun pool. All the pumps and filter are new, so we can expect a good water quality.

We can use the accommodation and the venue only on the ordered days with a certain number of people, because we are only a small part of all sports in the World Games organization.

The organization will pickup each team at the airport, take them to the accreditation and afterwards to the hotel. At the same time they carry the boats to the venue. It's up to each team to arrange its travel to and from Wroclaw. The organization will take care of the teams from our arrival in Wroclaw until our departure. To organize all the things for us we need to send the complete information very exactly to the organisation in Wroclaw (WOC)
